



### Application for CITES Permit

As part of our service, PetRelocation will apply for the CITES permit application on your behalf. Our service also includes all U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service fees and correspondence. In order to submit the application; we will need additional information on your pet. Please carefully review the following and remit the necessary answers using this form.

Please check the box next to the permit you would like us to apply for:

**CITES One-Time Import/Export Permit**

This permit is for one-time imports or exports of CITES-protected species. It is only good for one border crossing use.

**Use this if you:**

a) Plan on moving your pet overseas only once

**OR**

b) If your pet will be traveling unaccompanied (“cargo”).

**CITES Pet Passport Permit**

The pet passport is a CITES Certificate of Ownership for personally owned wildlife. The certificate acts like a passport to simplify the permit procedures for people who frequently travel internationally with companion animals. It is issued for a single animal, is valid for 3 years, and may be used for multiple border crossings.

**Use this if you:**

a) Plan on moving your pet overseas more than once in a period of 3 years

**AND**

b) Will be traveling with your pet as “accompanied baggage.”

**\*\*Pet must travel with owner in order to utilize the Pet Passport. \*\***

**Power of Attorney – Authorizing PetRelocation to submit the application.**

U.S. Fish & Wildlife requires a power of attorney in order to submit an application on someone else’s behalf. This ensures the permit will be in your name – not Pet Relocation’s – and will allow Pet Relocation to interact on your behalf with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Services.

3. If you **are the breeder**, we will need the following statement issued. If you **are not the breeder**, we need your breeder's **current contact information** to obtain a signed statement **from your breeder** stating the following:
- That the animal was bred & born at his/her facility;
  - Birth/hatch date, and if applicable band/tag number and sex of each specimen he/she bred;
  - Location of parental stock;
  - Complete name and address of the breeder's facility; and
  - Copies of documentation showing that you acquired the animal from the breeder or documentation demonstrating the history of transactions (chain ownership of the animal).

Please keep in mind that this requires cooperation on the part of your breeder. Obtaining this information can often be delayed if the breeder is not willing to correspond with PetRelocation.

**Frequently Asked Questions:**

- If you do not know the birth or hatch date, provide the approximate age of your pet or at least the date when you acquired it.
- If you do not know the sex, state "unknown."
- Indicate if the pet was born/hatched in captivity or taken from the wild. If you do not know, state "unknown."
- If your pet is **captive-bred** but you are unable to provide information about your pet's breeder, please provide all the information you know about the origin of the pet and a description of the circumstances under which you acquired the pet (i.e. date, name and address, etc.).
- If you **do not know the origin** of your pet(s) please provide a complete description of the circumstances under which you acquired the pet(s) (i.e. where, when from whom, etc.).
- If your pet **originated in the wild**, provide:
  - The country of origin;
  - The date the animal was removed from the wild;
  - The date it was acquired by you;
  - Copies of any foreign CITES permit(s) under which pets were previously exported/re-exported.
